DEBATING AS A KEY LIFE SKILL

- Structured thought and communication skills are key indicators of potential in applications to the world's best universities

- The course culminates in the students taking part in a debating competition

PHILOSOPHY, POLITICS AND ECONOMICS IN A GLOBAL CONTEXT

- This trio of subjects empowers students to study the major ideologies and policies of the world in undergraduate-level discussions
- Covering a range of themes, students learn to critically engage with the world around them
- Time is allocated to researching a chosen academic topic, guided by a mentor and concluding with a short essay; a perfect preparation for the Extended Essay component of the International Baccalaureate, and for academic writing at university

DEVELOPING A GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE

- Classes are structured to encourage cooperation and mutual support, integrating a range of levels of debating experience amongst the students
- The international perspective of our students and their diverse backgrounds further emphasises the benefits of cooperative learning
- The combination of critical thinking with debate is key to the Global Young Leaders approach and equips students to find what they want to say, whilst empowering them to say it
- The skills of critical thinking, understanding of current affairs, and confident presentation of perspectives are beneficial to students of all disciplines

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION

- Mock university interviews and advice on writing a personal statement

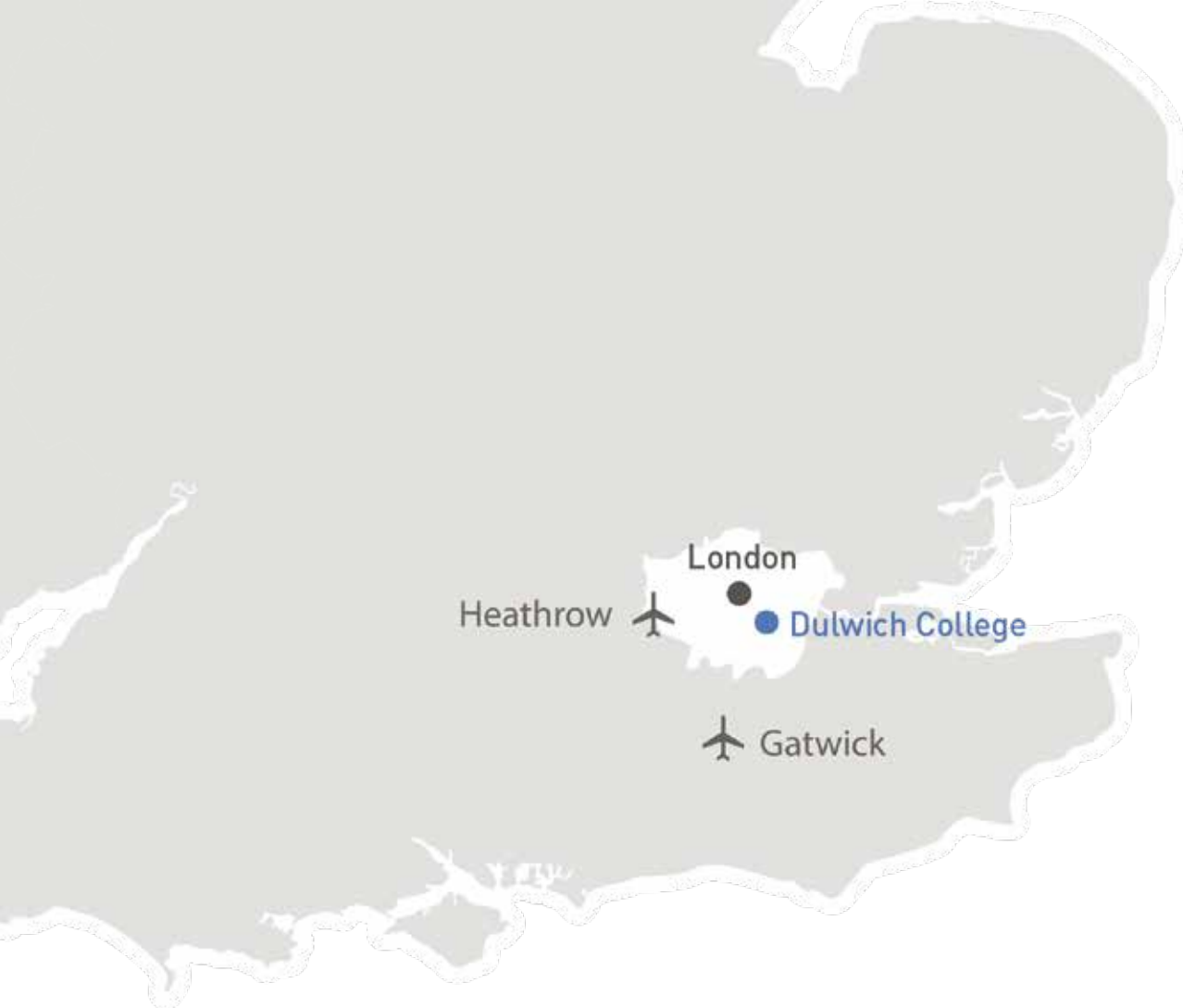
3. Please fill in all required medical, personal and transfer forms and return to us by email as soon as possible.

COURSE REGULATIONS

1. Students will be subject to the course rules. In particular, they will be required to attend all meals, lessons and arranged activities and excursions.
2. Students will be responsible for keeping their own rooms tidy.
3. All damages to property, equipment and rooms will be charged to the students and must be settled within 24 hours.
4. Consumption of alcohol by students is not permitted (note it is against the law in Britain for persons under the age of 18 to purchase alcohol). Alcohol must not be brought into the school premises by students of any age.
5. Drug-taking or suspicion of drug-taking of any kind will result in immediate dismissal.
6. Smoking is not permitted in school premises at any time.
7. Girls and boys may not enter each other's bedrooms or other designated areas under any circumstances.
8. Students will be required to be in their rooms and to maintain silence at a certain time prescribed by the Centre Manager.
9. Bullying will not be tolerated and may, at the discretion of the Centre Manager, result in expulsion from the course.
10. Students will be expected to show courtesy to all course staff and domestic staff and to behave in a civilised manner on and off the campus.

NB: Students breaking any of the rules of the course they are attending may be dismissed within 24 hours at their own expense and without refund.
